The importance of obtaining a legal heir certificate cannot be overstated. It is required for various purposes related to inheritance and asset transfer.








#### **Property Transfer**

Though often confused, a legal heir certificate and succession certificate are not the same. Understanding the difference is crucial before proceeding with applications.


Legal Heir Certificate Proof of Heirship

# Who Can Apply for a Legal Heir Certificate?

The applicant must submit proof of their relationship to the deceased along with mandatory documents.
