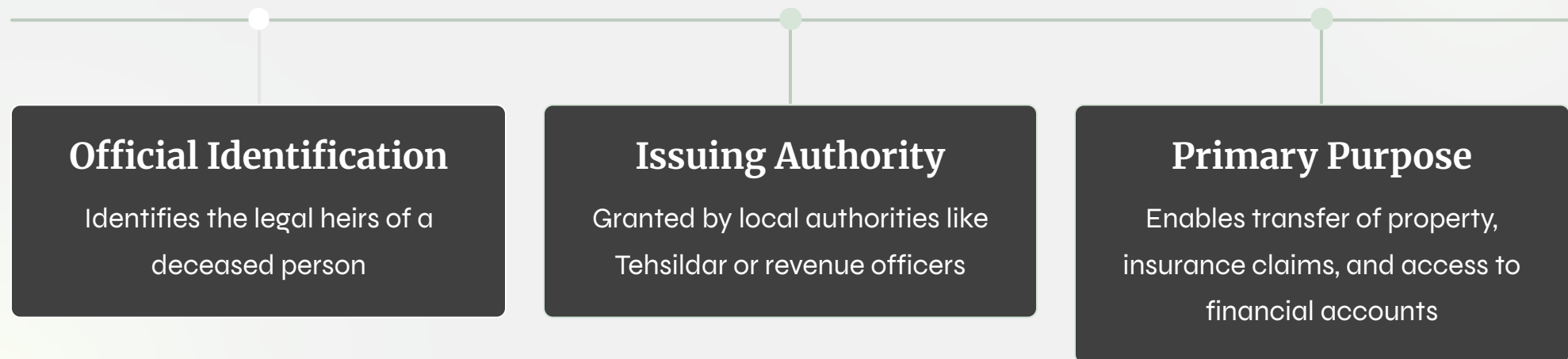


What is a Legal Heir Certificate?

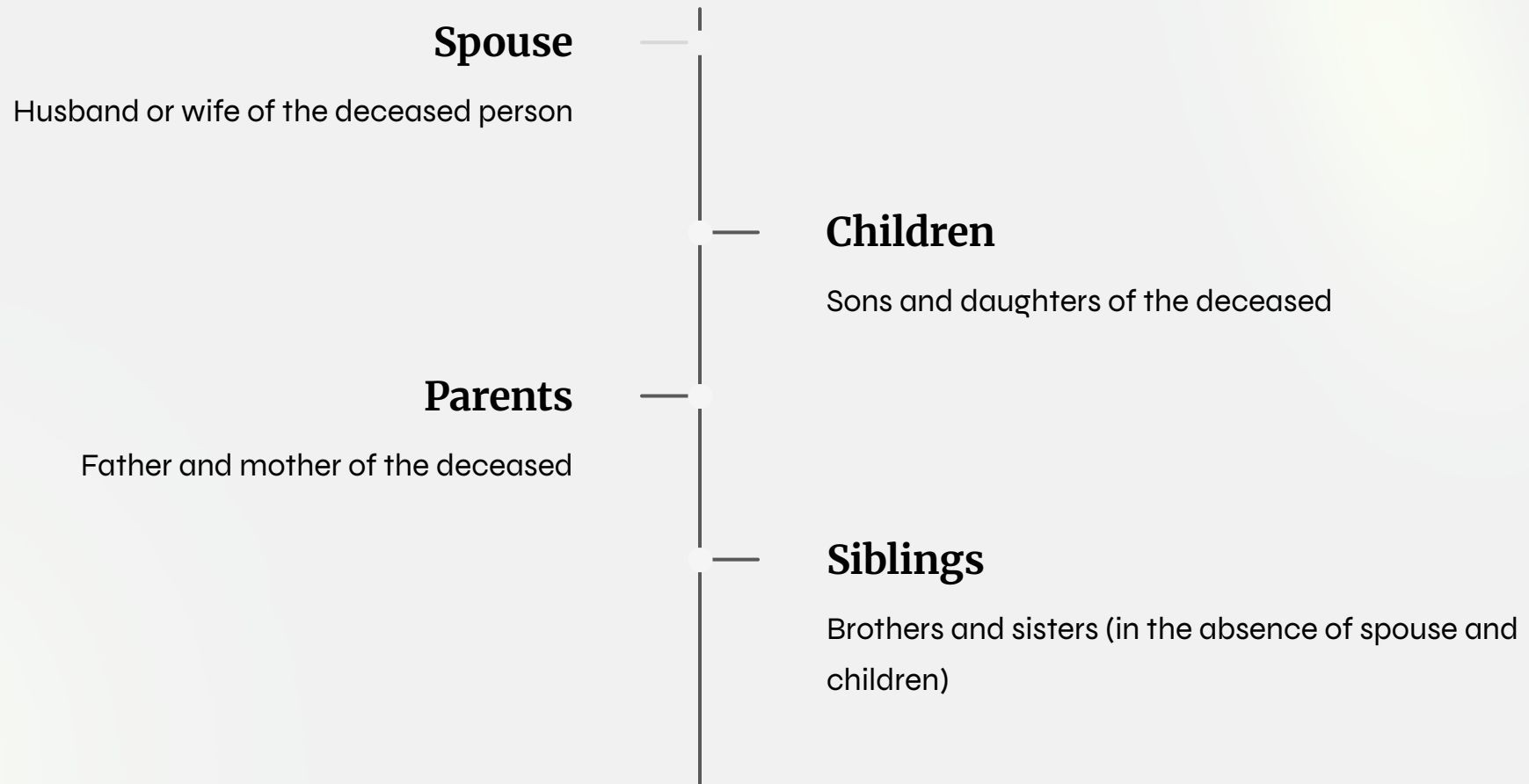

- ❏ A legal heir certificate is used mainly for establishing relationships and claiming benefits from government departments, while a succession certificate is issued by a court specifically to settle debts and securities of the deceased.

Who Can Apply for a Legal Heir Certificate?

Not everyone can apply for a legal heir certificate. Only certain family members related to the deceased are eligible to make an application.



The applicant must submit proof of their relationship to the deceased along with mandatory documents.

Documents Required for Legal Heir Certificate

The following documents are generally required while applying for a legal heir certificate:

Death Certificate

Aadhaar card or other identity proof of the applicant

Address proof of both the deceased and the applicant

Family Details

Family members' details and supporting proof

Affidavit

Affidavit of self-declaration

Photographs

Passport-sized photographs
